To qualify for this program, you must:

- ✓ Be a Pennsylvania resident
- Be able to attend all scheduled classes
- √ Have a social security number
- ✓ Be able to work legally in the U.S.
- ✓ Have at least a 5th grade English reading level
- Not have a criminal record
- Have satisfactory medical clearance
- Preferred, but not required: a high school diploma or GED, from any country
- ✓ Be able to lift 50 lbs. on a regular basis

All students must pass an English reading test and an oral interview.
