This is a summary of the Annual Report for the Philadelphia Hospital and Health Care District 1199C Training and Upgrading Fund, Employer Identification Number 23-7418594 Plan No. 501 for the period July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. This Annual Report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the Plan, was \$5,452,121 as of June 30, 2017 compared to \$5,451,676 as of July 1, 2016. During the plan year, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$445. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$9,550,900, including employer contributions of \$4,219,679, grant income of \$5,136,397, earnings from investments of \$34,284 and other income of \$160,540.

Total Plan expenses were \$9,550,455. This included administrative expenses of \$6,806,374 and payments to provide benefits of \$2,744,081.
