Nurse Aide Part-time Instructor

Job Description

The Nurse Aide Instructor is a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse who has the interest, ability, and knowledge to prepare students to become safe and competent Nurse Aides who can pass the state competency evaluation for Nurse Aides. This person must respect the contribution of Nurse Aides to the healthcare industry.

Instructors teach part time for day or evening classes.

Essential Functions and Duties:

- Follows the state-approved curriculum to ensure instruction occurs according to the state regulations and requirements.
- Provides instruction in the classroom setting, laboratory setting, and clinical setting.
- Regularly assesses student attainment of the required didactic and clinical competencies.
- Seeks to ensure that students are fully prepared and confident in sitting for the state competency evaluation of theory and clinical skills.
- Fosters good relationships with clinical affiliates.
- Attends monthly staff meetings.
- Attends professional development pertinent to improving instructional practices.

Required Qualifications:

- 1. Graduate of an approved Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse program.
- 2. Current license as a Registered or Practical Nurse in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 3. Minimum of two (2) years experience as a nurse in the long term care industry.
- 4. Nurse Aide Instructor must first complete Teaching the Educator workshop course, and be approved by PA Department of Education before they may teach any part of a Nurse Aide Training Competency Evaluation Program (NATCEP).
- 5. Teaching experience preferred.
- 6. Ability to facilitate student learning versus the traditional lecture.
- 7. Excellent documentation and organizational skills.
- 8. Ability and desire to work with a diverse student population.
- 9. Ability to use Microsoft Office products at an intermediate level.

Personal Qualities:

- 1. Able to work well with supervisors, peers, and students (youth and adults).
- 2. High level of integrity.
- 3. Good problem solving skills.
- 4. Able to apply critical thinking skills to resolve situations.
